This is a reminder that the first meeting of the new Coalition of Nassau Civic Associations ("Coalition") will take place tomorrow. Please join us at this exciting re-birth of a civic coalition that resolves to work together toward improving the quality of life of our collective communities. United we are strong!

Please take the time to review our By-Laws by [clicking here](#) as these By-Laws exemplify our resolve to form a more perfect union where all people, their communities and their civics are equally represented. To that end, this new Coalition's primary governing body is a Council of Delegates with one Delegate representing each civic association. On Tuesday evening, the Council of Delegates will elect the Coalition's 11 member Board of Directors (one Director from each District). The Board will then, at a later date, elect the Coalition's officers. The new organization continues to be based on representative districts having relatively equal populations, using the New York State Assembly District lines. Recent redistricting of the Assembly established two additional districts in Nassau County, for a total of 11 districts. Thus, the [Coalition's districts](#) also needed to be transitioned accordingly with new By-Laws that reflect the new districts.

Please consider applying for or nominating a board member from your civic association to join the Coalition's Board. Yes, we are all busy people, but the possibilities of what this Coalition can achieve is only limited by our imagination. Our communities have the same needs as our neighboring communities. There is strength in numbers.

All civic associations and their boards in Nassau County are invited to the Coalition's first meeting. Initial membership dues are \$1 per civic association, which will provide an opportunity for that civic association to vote for a Director to represent their interests on the new Coalition's Board. The \$1 fee can be paid tomorrow night. Attendees will be seated with their neighboring civic associations within each district. After group discussions, one member from each Member Civic will vote to elect one Director to represent them for their District on the Coalition's Board of Directors.
