Common Winter Storm Tips and Contacts

Common Winter Storm Tips:

- Have sufficient food, including, non-perishable foods, water, medications, batteries, gas, etc.)
- Please check in with any neighbors who may need assistance, especially elderly residents; offer help.
- During the storm please keep all cars off the street so that snowplows can safely and effectively keep roads plowed and/or sanded. Whenever possible, pile your shoveled snow on your lawn – not into the street.
- **Always use your best judgment** - whenever possible, avoid driving or being out in during the storm.
- **Residents with sidewalks** – In almost all municipalities, homeowners and businesses are required to shovel their sidewalks. Corner properties need to clear their side road sidewalks as well. When snowfall ends, do your best to have your sidewalks cleared of snow as quickly as possible, esp if you have frequent school or LIRR pedestrian traffic on your street(s) - it helps neighbors avoid having to walk in the road. Avoid shoveling snow into the street, since road snowplowing will often dump that snow right back on your sidewalk. Instead, pile the snow onto grass areas whenever possible. **If you're in good health to be able to do the work, offer help to neighbors. If you're not up to the stressful and physical work of shoveling snow, don't put your own health at risk - ask for help from others.**
