Sun sets for Sunset Chapels — New BMW Dealership to Arise in its Place.

Construction fencing went up during the week of November 13th to surround the site of the former Sunset Chapels funeral home on Northern Boulevard. Asbestos abatement will be performed in the old building before it is demolished over the coming weeks. Site development work is expected to begin shortly after demolition of the old structure. It will involve removal of certain trees and bushes that line the borders of the lots under development and regrading of portions of the property. Construction of the new building is expected to take a year or more, following which new plantings will be installed to screen Norgate residences from activity on the BMW site and the noise, lights, and activity along Northern Boulevard.

The history of the proposed redevelopment of the Sunset Chapels site was recounted in the Fall 2022, February 2023, and Summer 2023 issues of the Norgate News, which are all available on the NCA tab of the web site of the Council of Greater Manhasset Civic Associations at https://www.manhassetcivic.org/nca/.

We have established a good working relationship with the owner of the site and hope to work with him and his company to address any issues that may arise during construction. When construction is complete, we expect that a handsome, new BMW dealership building will occupy the site and that the dealership will prove a good neighbor for years to come.
